Use active listening

### **Emotional Intelligence – Exercise**

# Comparative Advantage – something you can produce at a lower opportunity cost than someone else (something you are good at!)

To see others' comparative advantage:

- Don't assume things
- Pay attention to detail
- Celebrate diversity (of thought and action)
- Be mindful of your end goal

#### **Comparative Advantage – Exercise**

Using the relationship from a previous exercise, ask yourself the following:

Do I assume I know what he/she will say when I need to ask them for something and how does that affect what I decide to do?

Do I pay attention to him/her or would I rather not bother getting to know that person well?

Am I defensive when he/she shares a different opinion or viewpoint than me on matters I find important?



Am I aware of what I am trying to achieve with this relationship?

## Build a positive work environment

- Don't overthink a colleague's intentions
- Help others succeed
- Be respectful
- Recognize different communication styles
- Ask more questions
- Address issues head-on
- Promote a sense of trust
